

Public evaluation report Results of open call "Monitoring the effect of Covid-19 in Prisons and Mental Health Institutions"ⁱ

On September 28, 2020 Netherlands Helsinki Committee launched an open regional call for proposals "Monitoring the effect of COVID-19 prevention and treatment measures on the conditions of people confined to closed institutions" for CSOs in Armenia, Georgia, Moldova, and Ukraine within scope of EU funded "Covid-19 Solidarity Programme 2020-2022."

NHC received 10 applications for this Call. The designated evaluation committee recommended that Helsinki Citizens' Assembly - Vanadzor (HCAV) in Armenia, Penal Reform International (PRI) in Georgia, Moldovan Institute for Human Rights (IDOM) in Moldova, and Ukraine Without Torture in Ukraine may be awarded the project contract values of 6.000 EUR, 6.000 EUR, 5.998 EUR, and 12.000 EUR, respectively. All proposers have been informed about the evaluation results on their proposals for this Call.
